STATEMENT ON TOXIC SUBSTANCES CONTROL ACT (TSCA) / PERSISTENT, BIOACCUMULATIVE AND TOXIC (PBT) CHEMICAL COMPLIANCE

ISSUED BY: Teledyne DALSA, a business unit of Teledyne Digital Imaging, Inc.

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On January 6, 2021, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) amended the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) to restrict certain chemicals that are Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic (PBT). Processing and distribution of the following chemicals, and products containing these chemicals, are restricted:

- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
- Decabromodiphenyl Ether (DecaBDE)
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

On October 28, 2021, the EPA proposed a further amendment to the Act to extend the compliance deadline for the restriction of Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1)) to October 31, 2024. Accordingly, we continue to monitor the use of this chemical in the materials procured for manufacture of our products. We will continue to monitor the status of the amendment as well.

To the best of our knowledge, Teledyne DALSA products do not contain any of the chemicals listed above.

Teledyne DALSA has used reasonable methods to ensure the accuracy of this information. We have however relied upon information provided by our suppliers that we are not able to independently verify.
